Legislative Update

The Legislature is currently on recess and will reconvene on January 3, 2018 for the second year of the two year session. Bills that failed passage or were held as two-year bills can be taken up in January so we anticipate a number of issues will be back on the table.

Upon the Legislature’s return, bills will be introduced leading up to the February 16 deadline. Following the bill introduction deadline, the CPPCA Legislative Committee will be meeting in Sacramento to review and recommend positions on all introduced legislation in which CPPCA will weigh in on during the year.

Legislative Analyst’s Office Budget Report

The LAO released a budget outlook for the 2018-19 budget. Under their current estimates, the State would have \$19.3 billion in total reserves (including \$7.5 billion in discretionary reserves) at the end of 2018-19, assuming the Legislature makes no additional budget commitments. They also estimate the Legislature will have \$5.3 billion in uncommitted school and community college (Proposition 98) funds to allocate in 2018-19. We are likely to see the estimates among the LAO and Department of Finance reconciled as the budget process begins after the beginning of the year with the Governor’s January budget proposal.
