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LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

Friday, September 13th was the deadline for all bills to be passed for the 2013 legislative session. The Governor has until October 13th to sign or veto all legislation on his desk. Below is a list of bills that have passed the Legislature and are now on the Governor's desk. We will continue to keep you updated as actions are taken by the Governor. The Legislature is now adjourned for the remainder of the year and will return on January 6, 2014.

CA AB 48 Skinner (D)	Firearms: Large-Capacity Magazines Makes it a misdemeanor crime to buy or receive a large capacity ammunition magazine or to manufacture, import, keep for sale, offer or expose for sale, or give, lend, buy or receive any related conversion kit. CA SB 131 Beall (D)	Damages: Childhood Sexual Abuse: Statute of Limitations Provides that the time limits for commencement of an action for recovery of damages suffered as a result of childhood sexual abuse shall be retroactive to any claim that has not been adjudicated to finality on the merits as of a specified date. Revives an action that would be barred by that statute of limitations, under specified conditions. Limits the liability of the fund to damages of a specified amount for any single home for all claims arising during a specified period. Requires that multiple incidents of a general course of conduct be considered one occurrence. CA SB 530 Wright (D)	Criminal Offenders: Rehabilitation Prohibits a public or private employer from asking an applicant to disclose, or from utilizing as a factor in determining any condition of employment, information concerning a conviction that has been judicially dismissed or ordered sealed unless the applicant would be required to use a firearm in the course of employment.
